

CAMP RULES

1. Register at the head of the camp directly after arriving at the surf camp
2. Keep the camp clean (throw the trash, also cigarettes, in the bin! Full garbage bags go in the garbage containers)
3. Keep the sanitation facilities clean. You can find cleaning material (wiper) inside the facilities (they are cleaned every day, but you might want to keep them as clean as possible in your own interest)
4. Respect the night's rest between 11 pm and 7 am.
5. Damages to material, tents or other camp facilities have to be reported to the head of camp or the port office directly.
6. Only group guests are allowed to use the kitchen and day room inventory (tables, benches, dishes, etc.). The usage has to take place at the respective locality. The cleaning takes place directly after the meals at appropriate sink.
7. The fireplace has to be cleaned up after usage as well as the barbecue.
8. Groceries have to be stored in the kitchen.
9. Water sports equipment has to be taken out of the water and brought back to the store after usage. Exception: you can leave your surfboard at the beach until 6 pm (if you still want to use it).
10. Clean your wet suit after usage and hang it up on the hangers in front of your hut (don't hang it on trees or fences)
11. Water sport is absolutely forbidden in reed areas
12. The shipping channel has to be crossed as fast as possible (ships have priority!). Swimming in the shipping channel is forbidden by the police.

13. Unauthorized persons (everybody who didn't register at the head of camp) are not allowed to be on the premises.
14. The head of camp is only liable in the bound of existing insurance contracts, but not for damages, accidents, loses, cancellations due to the weather & delays of every description.
15. The group leader is responsible for his or her group to adhere to camp rules.
